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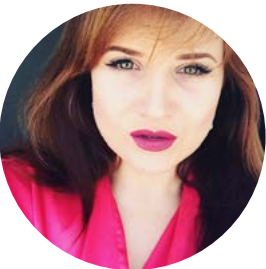
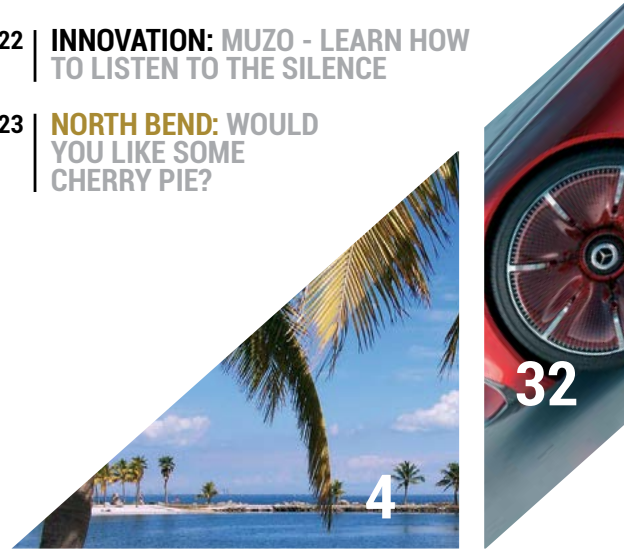
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Things to do CHICAGO

I'd also suggest you take a quick look at the Mick Jagger portrait in the corner, post it, and check out the high-end open kitchen Beatrix is famous for.

Nowadays, they say that a modeling career is only about contrived smiles that disappear right after the camera is turned off. But the reason for the photo shoot is not only to preserve a beau-

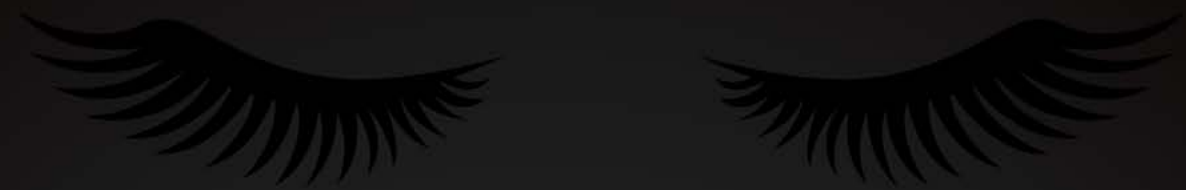

That idea, of course, is a great one, but it breaks some physical laws and is impossible for the moment.

But it's not as bad as it seems! Recently Kickstarter (the world's largest funding platform for creative projects) released a unique gadget that allows you to achieve absolute silence and save the wear and tear on your nervous system. Curious, right?

The name of that gadget is Muzo, and it works by applying anti-vibration technology. The sounds we hear come in the form of vibrations, so the farther we are from the source of the sound, the less we can hear it. This device can block sound vibrations

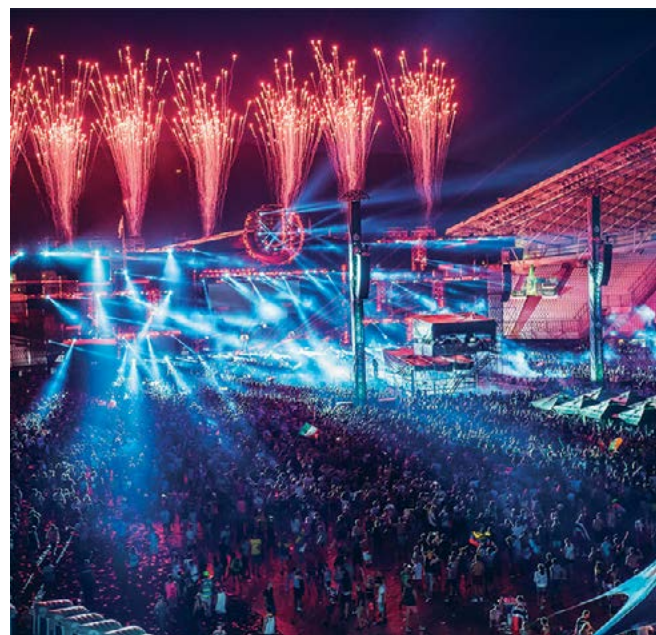

Spring MAKEUP



Every woman wishes to be perfect and to feel confident about herself on that day. After all, it's a day that features many proposals. One of the most important things is your makeup, and so now that's what we'll talk about.

Makeup should be delicate and soft because men usually want to see their better half as a delicate angel rather than bright and sparkly like a Christmas tree. So put the accent on fresh and shining skin.

First things first: let's get everything ready! Sounds like an excuse to go shopping, right?

WE ARE GOING TO USE:

- Foundation
- Concealer
- Translucent finishing powder
- Highlighter with warm undertones
- Bronzer
- Eyebrow styler
- Brown eye pencil
- Brown eye shadow, white eye shadow with frosted finish, frosted white eye shadow (I have pink and gold undertones)
- Mascara
- Clear or light lip gloss

Start by exfoliating dead cells with the help of a face scrub. Then hydrate the skin with a rich moisturizing cream because during the winter months skin needs more care and hydration than during the summer. Wait about 15-20 minutes so the cream can soak in. And after that, you can start doing your makeup. Apply foundation all over your face with a sponge, brush, or your finger. Pay attention to the front of your face near the ears and hairline, where the absence of foundation is especially noticeable. The right shade of foundation is the shade of your lower cheek near the neck. Concealer will help you to hide dark spots under your eyes and in the inner corner of the eye. Set the concealer with translucent finishing powder.



Then apply the highlighter under your eyebrows, on the cheekbones, and on the central part of your upper lip. Apply bronzer under the cheekbones to make your face look fuller and your cheeks less prominent.

Apply matt brown shadow on your eyelids and blend it from dark to light.

Apply some white shadow on the inner corner of your eye and on your eyebrow bones, and just a bit of frosted white on the middle of the eyelid for freshness. You can use the same frosted white shadow as a highlighter.

You want to stay feminine and delicate, but the wings of the eyes look very dramatic. Draw the line with a brown eye pencil on the lower lash line and blend it with a brush or a Q-tip. You don't have to put anything on your eyebrows; just style them with a smart tool: an eyebrow styler. In that case, the look will be softer.

Put just a little bit of mascara on your lashes.

It's better to use lip gloss instead of lipstick. These days many brands offer sweet lip glosses.

And remember that any look should be completed with your own self-confidence. So don't be shy. Exude your inner light, and everything will happen the way you want it. I hope you are the happiest woman around!

MERCEDES MAYBACH 6

UNITY OF STYLE
AND FUNCTION



Auto companies never get tired of surprising us with new cars. It seems that in our century of non-stop progress, a company has to differentiate itself from all the rest, right? Mercedes-Benz shows us how to do this easily and effectively.

Not long ago, Mercedes unveiled the stunning Maybach 6 coupe in Pebble Beach, California, in a so-called “beauty contest” car show. It features an

elegant design and powerful functionality. Just hearing that, you’ll want to take this car out on the speedway. To understand all of the uniqueness of this car, you

need to be familiar with a couple of its nuances.

First of all, you should know that the “6” in the name refers to a six-meter-long body with plenty of power.

This model is totally electric. A massive battery pack located along the bottom powers four motors, one per wheel. The engine can achieve nearly 750 horsepower, and the car will hit 60 mph in less than four seconds — a great result! Mercedes says

the car offers a driving range of more than 200 miles. And with quick charging on the Combined Charging System standard, a five-minute jolt can add 62 miles of range. It can also be recharged wirelessly.

The exterior looks very smooth: gullwing doors, split backlight, boat tail rear, sleek hood, 24-inch rims, and a grille on the front made to look like the pinstripes on a suit. This makes the car totally distinctive.

The interior boggles the imagination with “inside-out” technology. The seat bottoms extend up into the door panels and the center console. The digital display screen runs the full width of the dash and even onto the door panels. Additionally, the windshield functions as a giant head-up display and is operated via gesture controls. Blue illuminated panels are futuristic.

Unfortunately, there is no release date and we don’t know when the Mercedes Maybach 6 will be available. So stay tuned.

While creating the Nike Free RN Motion Flyknit shoe, engineers also took into account the design. So you can run with ease and in style. Coming up are different colors to please any buyer.

The sole has another secret—it consists of two kinds of coating. One is inside, and it's softer for the comfort of your foot. The second one is outside. This one is firm so that the shoes will last longer and not lose their appearance. The cloth upper part uses high-strength fibers stitched together in a shape that conforms to your foot while staying light and supportive where it's needed the most.

Running in these shoes helps you avoid falling or sustaining leg injuries. Running can be dangerous, but if you use the best shoes you can be safe and get positive results.
